Follow Route 23 East to New Holland. Turn right on South Kinzer Avenue. Travel for approximately ¼ mile, then turn left to enter Garden Spot Village.

**From Pennsylvania Turnpike:**

Take exit 22 (Morgantown) and follow Route 10 South to Route 23 West. Turn left on Kinzer Avenue. Travel approximately ¼ mile, then turn left to enter Garden Spot Village.

**From Downingtown and West Chester:**

Take Route 322 West to the intersection of Route 23 and Route 322. Follow Route 23 West to Kinzer Avenue and turn left. Travel approximately ¼ mile, then turn left to enter Garden Spot Village.

**From Ephrata:**

Take Route 322 East to the intersection of Route 23 and Route 322. Follow Route 23 West to Kinzer Avenue. Turn left on Kinzer Avenue. Travel approximately ¼ mile, then turn left to enter Garden Spot Village.

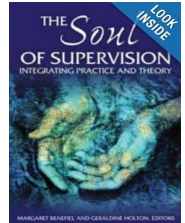
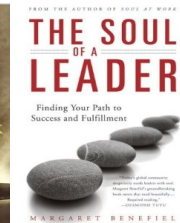
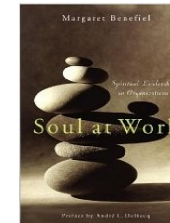
