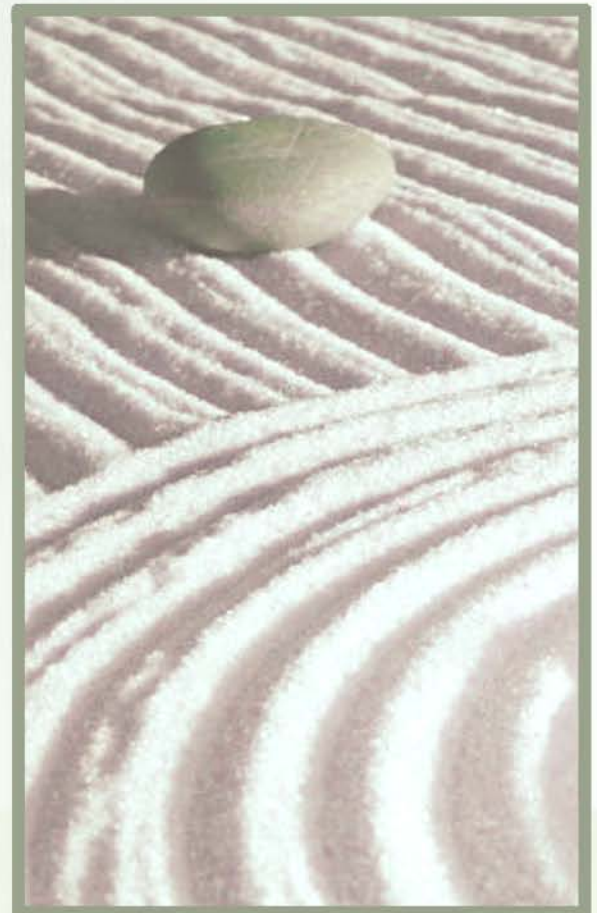

In twenty-first century Western culture, leaders are rewarded for their drive, decisiveness, productivity, and long work hours. What would it look like for a leader to cultivate the inner life, to step off the treadmill, to take time apart for personal reflection? What would leadership arising from a core of spiritual groundedness and compassion look like?

In this 10-week program, participants will:

- 1) Identify the times they have led with soul and learn how to do so more consistently.
- 2) Reflect on their own leadership experiences in light of the readings.
- 3) Learn to practice discernment in difficult leadership challenges.
- 4) Reflect on their own spiritual awareness and resources in relation to their particular leadership situations.
- 5) Learn to apply several leadership approaches and discern which is best for their own style and situation.
- 6) Learn to break the cycle of destructive communication through nonviolent communication practices.
- 7) Reflect on their own family emotional and spiritual formation and how it can be a resource for their leadership.



We will meet in person twice – February 9 and April 23 (these will be day-long gatherings in Portland, OR). In between, there will be three small group meetings, and online community.
